- ☐ Passport or Identification Card (ID) (*for initial licence validation only*).

²Freelance pilots can only apply for general aviation and 1 year only.



Guidance Notes for validation process for International General Aviation and Commercial Air Transport operations

[Some National Aviation Authorities (NAA) have differing requirements depending on the type of operations being performed (GA or CAT) and depending on the pilot's operating role (PIC or SIC).

For International General Aviation Operations

For validation purposes, the San Marino CAA requires a pilot operating for International General Aviation operations to hold a licence which supports the requested privileges.

In some States, the NAA requires qualification by experience, in which case suitable evidence shall be submitted with the application (certified logbook, record of recency or record of instructor/Examiner declaration).

In some States, the NAA requires a competence check to be performed by a person authorised by the State NAA. Supporting evidence of such authorisation and evidence of the competence check shall accompany the application (i.e. certified in the logbook, separate declaration/certification, record of check/test).

In some States, the NAA requires a proficiency check to be performed by a person authorised by the State NAA. Supporting evidence of such authorisation and record of check shall be submitted with the application (i.e. States Licence Proficiency Check or Approved ATO's form/record).

For Commercial Air Transport Operations

For validation purposes, the San Marino CAA requires a pilot operating under an AOC issued by San Marino CAA to hold a licence whose privileges will permit Commercial Air Transport operations.

In the event that the licence does not confer CAT privileges to operate commercial air transport operations, the San Marino CAA will accept an operator's proficiency check (OPC) completed by an approved training provider's authorised examiner that ensures that the OPC form makes clear that the check/test completed meets equivalent standards for commercial air transport operations.

This OPC document shall be submitted together with the State of Licence issued proficiency/competency check to the CAA.]
