Information Circular No. 39 Issue 01

Extinguishing Agent used in Portable Fire Extinguishers

This circular serves to inform that the Government of the Republic of San Marino has not adopted the EC Regulation 2024/590 (the Ozone Regulation).

For aircraft registered in the Republic of San Marino, the following requirements apply:

- CAR OPS 1.790(g), or
- CAR OPS 2A.402(b)(3), or
- CAR OPS 2H.407(b), or
- CAR OPS 3.790(b), or
- CAR SPO A.580(g)

These regulations state that any extinguishing agent used in a portable fire extinguisher for aircraft with an individual certificate of airworthiness issued on or after December 31, 2018, must not be of a type listed in Annex A, Group II of the Montreal Protocol on Substances that Deplete the Ozone Layer.

The requirements are aligned with the corresponding ICAO Standards and Recommended Practices (SARPs) in Annex 6, Part 1, § 6.2.2.1; Part 2, § 2.4.2.3; and Part 3, § 4.2.2.1.

Should the regulations change, the SM CAA will provide appropriate notification.
